

PUPIL CODE OF CONDUCT

GUIDELINES

As a pupil at this school you will be expected to take full responsibility for your own actions, have self-discipline, and respect others and the school environment.

You must take care of any valuable items or money you bring into school and make sure that your belongings have your name on them.

Your behaviour in and around the school, on the journey to and from school, or on school outings, must reflect the following guidelines which are designed to create a pleasant, safe working atmosphere for all of us.

Serious breaches of the school code of conduct may lead to sanctions including detentions, inclusion or suspension.

A YOU WILL BE EXPECTED TO:

- 1. Wear the correct school uniform at all times.
- 2. Arrive at school and at all lessons on time.
- 3. Be polite and courteous to everyone.
- 4. Work hard in all lessons and on homework.
- 5. Treat all staff, students and visitors with respect.
- 6. Put your litter in bins provided.
- 7. Move around the school in a calm orderly manner (keeping to the left in corridors).
- 8. Care for the buildings, furniture and equipment.
- 9. Eat food and snacks only in the permitted areas.

B YOU WILL BE EXPECTED NOT TO:

- 1. Behave in any way which is dangerous to others.
- 2. Use obscene language at any time.
- 3. Use physical violence on any occasion.
- 4. Chew gum, eat food or snacks, or drink in class or in school buildings.
- 5. Drop litter anywhere on the school site.
- 6. Speak disrespectfully to any member of staff.
- 7. Bully other students either physically, verbally or electronically.
- 8. Smoke or bring cigarettes/e-cigarettes, alcohol, aerosols or any illegal substances to school.
- 9. Leave the school site without permission.
- 10. Go into any out-of-bounds areas.
- 11. Use mobile phones or electronic devices within the school grounds.
- 12. Use any camera or video function on a mobile phone within the school grounds or building.
